Leaving Arken we continue South to the quaint little town of Præstø (Priest Island) and the lovely Inn and Hotel called [Frederiksminde](#) where we will have an exquisite dinner and stay overnight.

On the Thursday morning we move at a leisurely pace to the [Forest Tower](#) — another unique piece of architecture located in the woods from which we will hopefully get a splendid view of the Danish landscape. The Forest Tower has been short listed for the European Union’s Architecture Award 2022, the Mies van der Rohe Award, and it is one of the top 100 places in the World to visit, according to Time Magazine. We are in the vicinity of numerous Danish Castles, and we will proceed to visit one of them to get a flavour of historical Denmark. We will get a unique and exclusive tour of the castle called [Gisselsfeld](#), one of the largest — and best run — castle estates in Denmark, followed by a lunch at the castle itself, before we set off towards Copenhagen, again arriving in downtown Copenhagen or at the Copenhagen airport mid-afternoon.
